COMAN TIEBREAK PROCEDURE

The Coman tiebreak procedure is identical to the regular tiebreak EXCEPT that the players change ends after the 1st point, and then after every 4 points, and at the conclusion of the tiebreak.

a) use for both set and match tiebreaks

b) player whose turn it is to serve shall serve first point from the deuce court

c) first point served to the deuce court, players then change ends and the following two points shall be served by the opponent(s) (in doubles, the player of the opposing team due to serve next) starting from the add court

d) then each player/team shall serve alternately for two consecutive points (starting from the ad court), change ends after every 4 points until the end of tiebreak

e) you change ends after points 1,5,9,13,17....and at conclusion

EASY TO REMEMBER - players change ends after 1st point, then change after every 4 points, each player serves on the side they served from during the set

NOTE: If old tiebreak format is started, players realize during tiebreak, then old format is used. A team MAY NOT play the old format, then request a "replay" using the Coman. Any match finished stands.
