Subject: Asheville Open Moved to 2021

Dear Friends,

You might have heard the disappointing news that the Asheville Open will be postponed until next year. As the pandemic continues to unfold, there appears to be little likelihood that we could host a successful event this July. The uncertainties—medical, economic, and human—are simply too great. This decision is one for the history books as, like Wimbledon, will not be held for the first time since World War II. In its 89th year, the Asheville Open is the south's longest running tennis tournament.

Accordingly, all ATA programs are suspended indefinitely. This includes all Junior and Adult Clinics, Junior Team Tennis, ACEing Autism, and Try Tennis. Registrations are closed. When it is deemed appropriate, we will publish a new program schedule, along with a list of requirements for the safe conduction of the activities. The health and well-being of the community is our highest priority. It is the hope of the ATA that conditions will improve and we can all get back on the tennis courts.
